The article addresses the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau's ban of class action waivers in contracts for financial services and products such as credits cards and banking services. The new rule will take effect 60 days following its publication in the Federal Register. Companies that provide financial services and/or products should monitor developments in Congress and the courts that may limit the scope of the new rule or overturn it altogether.
